

Tips for staying in a holiday cottage

Once you decide what area you're travelling to you can look around and see what cottages are nearby. How far away from the tourist attractions do you want to be? That's something worth considering, because you'll have to get from your cottage to the things that you want to see and do. How you do that likely depends on how far 'out of the way' the cottage is. If you don't have a car and need to walk or use public transportation to see the sights you'll probably want a cottage that's a little bit closer to where everything is. On the other hand, if you mainly came to the area to see nature and just enjoy the beauty and the peace of it, it might be better if the cottage you choose is a little bit farther out from town, so you won't have so many distractions.
